You can vote early from October 10-13 and 15-18, as well as on election day on October 19. Voting is open from 8am-8pm, and you are entitled to time off work to vote.



## Register to vote

You're eligible if you're a Canadian citizen, over 18, and have lived in BC for the last six months.



## Find out where to vote

In BC, you can vote at any polling station. If you'll be away, you can also request to vote by mail.
